AHA's PEARS (Pediatric Advanced Emergency Assessment, Recognition and Stabilization) Course

The AHA's PEARS (Pediatric Advanced Emergency Assessment, Recognition and Stabilization) Course has been updated to reflect new science in the 2015 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC. In this classroom-based, Instructor-led course, students learn how to use a systematic approach to quickly assess, recognize the cause, and stabilize a pediatric patient in an emergency situation.

During PEARS, students interact with real patient cases, and realistic simulations and animations to assess and stabilize pediatric patients experiencing respiratory and shock emergencies, and cardiopulmonary arrest. PEARS prepares students to provide appropriate lifesaving interventions within the initial minutes of response until a child can be transferred to an advanced life support provider.

Who Would Benefit from this Course?

Physicians and nurses not specializing in pediatrics, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, EMTs, respiratory therapists, prehospital and in-facility healthcare providers (outside of critical-care areas, outpatient clinic staff, school-based providers, and any other healthcare provider who infrequently sees critically ill or injured infants and children.
