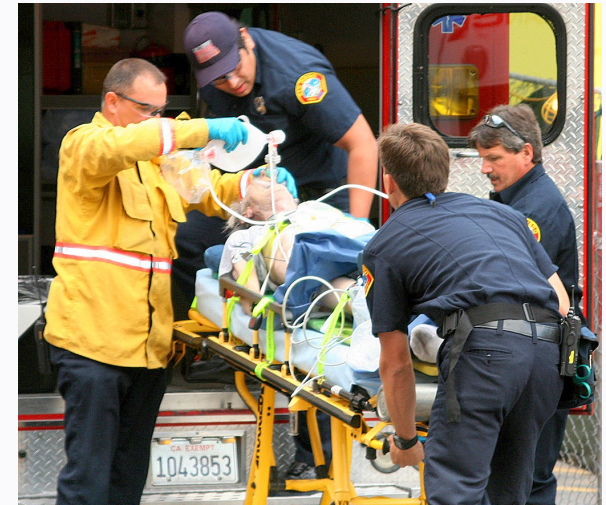

The *Law Enforcement First Responder (LEFR) Course* is continuing education offered through the National Association of EMT (NAEMT). This new course was developed in collaboration with the Denver Health Department of EMS Education and the Denver Police Department Metro/SWAT unit, and NAEMT's Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) Committee. This 8 hour course teaches public safety responders (police, law enforcement officers, firefighters and other first responders) the basic medical care interventions that will help save an injured responder's life until EMS practitioners can safely enter a tactical scene.
