NDEMSEA Board Meeting

October 5th, 2015 at 12:00 pm, NDEMSEA will be holding it's quarterly board meeting at the Ramada Inn, Bismarck, ND.

enters on both the local and regional were asked to lecture for this evening on matters important to EMS agencies in the state.

The conference began Tuesday afternoon on topics regarding Staff Orientation, Systems Development, Multi-Tasking, Group Purchasing, Working with Medical Directors and Resiliency in EMS. The final session of the day was a dinner session which began with Tom Fennell talking about the Savvik Buying Group and what it does for both NDEMSEA and the EMS Institute and then our national presenter Jess Fulkerson shared the importance of having a mentor and how we can all be a mentor. A networking social was held for all attendees following the final general session. Throughout the conference SIM-ND was present to share with EMS leaders what the simulation program was and to sign up services for training. On Wednesday Elizabeth Pihlaja from the EMSC Program at DEMST was on hand to talk about the EMSC program and give the attendees some free pediatric materials.

Wednesday's topics included Improving the Quality of your Organization, HIPAA, Clinical Issues and Remediation, Burnout in EMS, Working with Difficult People, and Recruitment, Onboarding, and Retention. The conference presenters and representatives from NDEMSEA and the Division of EMS and Trauma represented the panel in which attendees could address questions and concerns regarding relevant EMS matters or on what they learned while attending the conference. This panel discussion completed this conference, with many attendees even staying beyond the posted end time as there was great discussion on funding grants, education, and employee issues.

The association would like to extend a special thank you to Tom Fennell, Randy Fischer, Jess Fulkerson, Mike Grill, PJ Hardy, Ken Reed, Dr. Jeff Sather, Sherm Syverson, and Diane Witteman for sharing your experiences and expertise with the 76 attendees. Also, we appreciate the support and partnership of the Division of EMS and Trauma and the UND Center for Rural Health Flex Program. The Rural Assistance Center also was very kind and provided bags,

resuscitation, medication administration, and upper and lower respiratory distress.

Saturday will have a wide variety of breakout sessions featuring both LCCR and NCCR hours. Topics include HazMat, Oil & Gas Emergencies, Geriatric Emergencies, Landing Zone Safety, Pipeline Emergency Response, Mass Casualty, Developing a Culture of Safety in your Squad, Airway, Roles of Research, Cardiac Issues in Pediatric Patients, and Oxygenation.

On Saturday night, there will be a SIM truck challenge from 7 to 9 for ALS and BLS. Teams will compete in 10 minutes scenarios. The participants will be judged on teamwork, patient outcome, and communication. The winning team will receive a traveling trophy and a chance to compete at the EMS Rendezvous Conference in 2016. The SIM trucks will also be around Saturday and Sunday and two educational topics will be available.

Sunday sessions include Spinal Immobilization, Immunological Diseases, Chest Pain, Human Trafficking, Airway Management, Pediatric Transport, Patient Lifting, and Termination Decisions. The Southwest meeting will be held on Sunday as well.

Registration for the SW conference will be available August 15th, 2015. There is still time to book your hotel under the NDEMSEA block at the American Inn Motel and Suites for 82.10 a night. The block will be closed August 24th. We hope to see you in September.
